- Develop event sponsorship packages and sales strategies.
- Coordinate event timelines, communications, registration processes, sponsor fulfillment, and stakeholder engagement.
- Ensure events achieve revenue, attendance, and experience goals.
- Measure and report event performance, including sponsorship growth, attendance, revenue, expenses, and net proceeds.

### **Revenue Operations & Relationship Management**

- Maintain accurate records of sales activity, sponsorship commitments, member interactions, and revenue forecasts within the Chamber CRM (GrowthZone).
- Monitor membership revenue performance and lead internal staff on accurate billing, renewals, and account management.
- Ensure accurate reporting for leadership and Board review.



- Support development of annual membership materials, Impact Investor collateral, sponsorship packets, and revenue-generating campaigns.
- Leadership & Organizational Contribution
- Serve as a visible representative of the Chamber in the business community.
- Attend Chamber events, community meetings, and partner functions.
